Sinduartola Gramodaya Vikas Vidyalaya (SGVV) is a non-profit organization established in 1975 with a vision to create an egalitarian society where every individual has the opportunity to thrive. Initially SGVV started with a small learning centre for the children of the destitute community. Later, SGVV was registered as a legal entity under Society Registration Act 21-1860 in the year 1978. The organization started working with marginalized communities, including tribal and minority groups, marginal farmers, landless labourers, daily wage earners, displaced people, trafficked women, and girls with disabilities.

Now SGVV's programs focus on women's empowerment, promoting self-sufficiency through training and education. In the area of livelihood promotion, the organization supports marginalized communities in income generation through agriculture, handicrafts, and small-scale industries. SGVV also prioritizes health awareness, raising awareness about health issues and providing access to healthcare services. Additionally, the organization is committed to community development, strengthening local communities through programs focused on education, infrastructure, and social welfare. To protect children, SGVV works to combat child labour and trafficking, ensuring the well-being of children in vulnerable situations. Environmental sustainability is another key focus of SGVV. The organization works to protect and preserve the natural environment, promoting sustainable practices and addressing environmental challenges. Furthermore, SGVV is dedicated to social justice, combating corruption, discrimination, and exploitation. The organization strives to rehabilitate displaced individuals, child labourers, and trafficked girls, assisting them in reclaiming their rights and accessing opportunities they rightfully deserve.

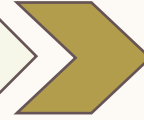

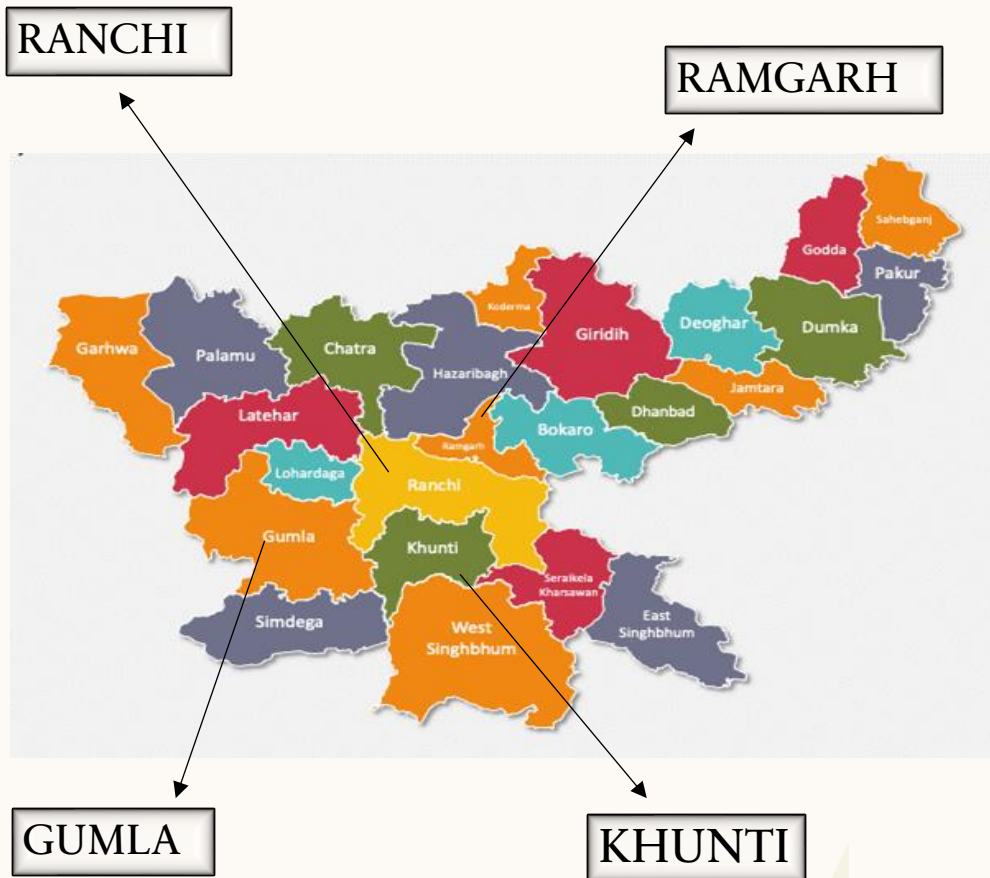

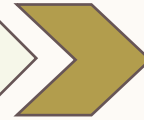

OUR STRATEGIES



1. Child rights and protection :

- Jharkhand is one of the states where a large number of women and adolescent children are caught by traffickers every year. Girls are particularly vulnerable to trafficking for various purposes, including forced labor, sexual exploitation, and use in armed conflict. SGVV has organized many awareness programs to create awareness among the tribal community regarding safe migration and the registration process in the labor department before going. SGVV has also organized training among groups, nuked natak, wall writing, and created awareness among the women SHG about the rights.

2. WOMEN EMPOWERMENT :

- Empowering women drives positive change for families, communities, and society, fostering sustainable development and social justice. SGVV's women's empowerment program in Khunti district is a prime example. By forming over 70 Self-Help-Groups (SHGs) for women and 12 for adolescent girls, SGVV has mobilized more than 5,000 members to support each other.
- These groups, linked with credit facilities and livelihood activities, inform women about their rights and government programs. Women in these SHGs actively address and resolve social issues like domestic violence and gender-based discrimination, creating a robust support system through regular meetings.



3. Anti-Trafficking & Safe Migration :

- For the past decade, SGVV has been at the forefront of protecting adolescent and young girls (A&YGs) from trafficking across 200+ villages. Our dynamic efforts focus on preventing unsafe migration often undertaken for employment.
- As a core committee member of the Jharkhand Anti-Trafficking Network (JATN), SGVV tackles safe migration. We champion women's right to safe mobility and were instrumental in passing the Jharkhand Domestic Workers Private Placement Agency Act, 2016. Our current mission: drafting the rules for this pivotal Act. Through these relentless efforts, we've built a formidable protective shield around A&YGs in our target areas.
- We've mobilized entire communities, educating and sensitizing them to this critical issue. We've empowered 20 groups of at-risk A&YGs and established 20 robust Village Vigilance Committees, all working in unison to halt unsafe migration.

4. Strengthening Gram Sabha and PRI :

- Local self governance has always been a challenge in Jharkhand. SGVV tackles this by offering training, technical assistance, and resources to strengthen local governance.
- Empowering communities to manages their own affairs promotes democracy, decentralization, and community resilience, leading to more inclusive and sustainable development.



5. Health, Hygiene & Sanitation :

- SGVV has launched dynamic initiatives to enhance community health. Through organized health check-ups camps and immunization awareness programs, we've positively impacted 5,000 self-help group (SHG) family members.
- Hygiene and healthy practices are now widely embraced by SHG members. We've constructed 2,000 low-cost toilets under the TSC program, revolutionizing sanitation. The resulting health improvements among our beneficiaries are both visible and transformative.

6. Agriculture, Livelihood & Food Security :

- Agriculture is a key focus area for SGVV, aimed at ensuring sustainable livelihoods and food security for marginalized farmers. We have identified and trained 1,500 farmers, forming 25 Women Farmer Self-Help Groups (WSHGs) and farmers Groups. These groups practice improved agricultural techniques, including SRI Paddy Cultivation, and are now actively engaged in organic farming, goat farming, poultry, and duck farming. This has enhanced the livelihoods and income of 1,500 families.
- Additionally, we have strengthened the MGNREGA scheme in 66 villages of Rania block through the CFT approach, employed rural youths and women. As a result, 75% of rural unemployed youths are now employed under MGNREGA, with 4,250 new job cards issued.

7. Enhancing life skills of adolescents :

- SGVV firmly believes that education is the cornerstone of social transformation. It empowers individuals, enriching their vision and understanding, and enabling informed action. Today, it has evolved into a well-established institution providing quality education to over 500 children from primary to 8th standard. Over 39 years, more than 2,000 children have received education and transitioned to higher education in government and private schools.
- We have educated and mainstreamed 500 dropout children from tribal and backward communities into government schools through Non-Residential Bridge Courses in Rania block, Khunti district. SGVV's extensive experience, expertise, and resources make us effective in grassroots literacy and education initiatives.

8. Environment Protection & Conservation :

- SGVV has ignited a green revolution in Rania block, unleashing a flurry of eco-conscious initiatives. From vibrant awareness camps to spirited rallies, from colorful painting competitions to grassroots village meetings, we're sparking a wildfire of environmental passion. Our message of forest protection, tree planting, polythene reduction, and cleanliness echoes through every corner, captivating SHGs, PRI representatives, community leaders, students, and teachers alike.
- Our green footprint stretches even further. Picture this: 5,000 trees now stand tall, their roots deep in school grounds, their branches reaching over roadsides, their leaves dancing on community lands. Each sapling is a testament to our commitment, a living, growing symbol of Rania's environmental renaissance.

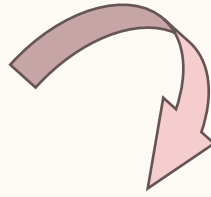

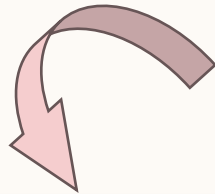

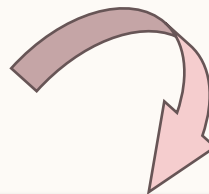

WORKING AREAS

1. Promoting safe mobility and counter trafficking in Jharkhand

The project titled "Promoting Safe Mobility and Counter Trafficking in Jharkhand," funded by BAT (British Asian Trust), is being implemented by the Jharkhand Anti-Trafficking Network (JATN). This initiative focuses on fostering safe mobility practices and countering human trafficking in various districts across Jharkhand.

SGVV is actively working in 1 districts and has established 10+ migrant forums at the community level. These forums disseminate information on safe migration, women's rights, and trafficking prevention. The network also engages with village communities, government stakeholders, and frontline workers like Sahiya didi and Anganwadi workers to promote awareness and implement effective interventions.

The project's approach is rights-based, emphasizing gender justice and the protection of marginalized groups, particularly women and children. SGVV has successfully reached over 800+ people, helping to integrate safe migration practices into local and state-level policies and programs.

CASE STUDY

Amit Yadav a bright and cheerful five-year-old from village Tuthtoli, Khunti, walked home from school on a typical Friday afternoon. As he turned the corner onto his street, a stranger approached him. Before Amit could react, the stranger quickly pulled him into a waiting van. The door slammed shut, and the van sped away. Luckily there was a shop nearby and the shopkeeper saw everything. Meanwhile, Amit's parents, Bhola Yadav and Roshni Devi, grew worried when he didn't arrive home on time. They searched the neighborhood, contacted friends, and asked people around, the shopkeeper told them about the incident. Since Roshni devi actively participated in all the meets and workshops of SGVV organized for the awareness of Child labor and trafficking, she immediately called the SGVV workers Renu and Surekha. They arrived in no time and went to the police station. It was a highly suspected that it might be the case of child labor or trafficking. Police took charge of the case. They assured Bhola and Roshni to do everything possible to bring Amit home safely. "As the hours ticked by, police widespread the news all over the areas, The police tracked the every signal hence tracing the van's location while crossing the Khunti boarder. The police team closed in, rescuing Amit just as the stranger was transferring him to another vehicle. Reunited with his overjoyed parents, Amit hugged them tightly. The stranger was apprehended, and Amit received counselling to cope with the traumatic experience. Bhola and Roshni including other villagers realized the importance of staying vigilant and teaching Amit and all other children additional safety measures which they acquired due the constant trainings organised by SGVV. Amit emerged stronger, more resilient, and grateful for his family's love and SGVV's support.

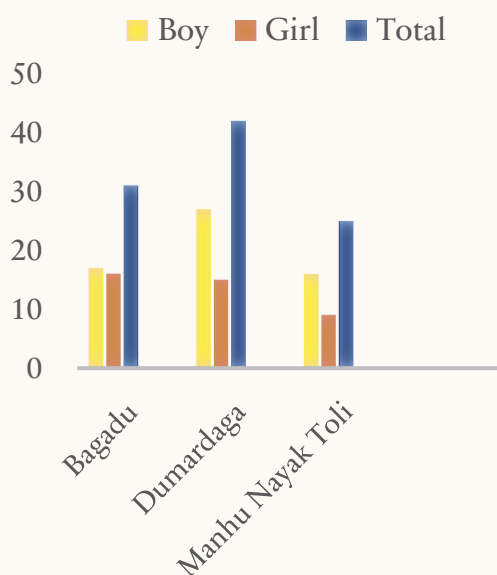
2. Pre School Nutrition and Education and RAHAT Support

This project, led by the Jiv Daya Foundation (JDF) in collaboration with Sinduartola Gramodaya Vikas Vidyalaya (SGVV), addresses critical issues of malnutrition and food insecurity in Khunti District, Jharkhand.

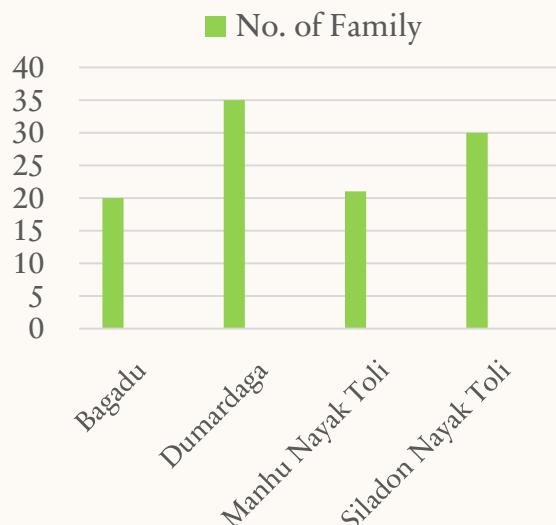
The Pre-School Nutrition and Education program focuses on combating malnourishment in young children through the provision of daily milk, directly targeting the early years of child development to prevent long-term health issues.

Currently, the Rahat Support initiative provides essential dry ration kits to vulnerable families who face severe socio-economic challenges, ensuring their access to basic nutrition and sustenance and Our organization distributed ration twice a year to a total of 106 poor families in four villages of Khunti district, namely, Bagru, Dumardaga, Manhu Nayak Toli and Siladon Nayak Toli. SGVV has also successfully distributed milk and biscuits daily to 100 children in three villages of Khunti district namely Bagru, Dumardaga and Manhu Nayak Toli so that all those children can get proper nutrition and education.

3. Access to Justice

We at Sinduar Tola Gramodaya Vikas Vidyalaya (SGVV) in Ranchi, Jharkhand, have been working tirelessly with the support of the Kailash Satyarthi Children's Foundation (KSCF), US, to ensure "Access to Justice" for vulnerable children in the community we work. From May 2023 to March 2024, we have implemented a comprehensive program aimed at combating child labour, child trafficking, child marriage, and child sexual abuse in the district.

Our operational area primarily covers the Ormanjhi block, comprising 57 villages and 10 panchayats. Throughout this reporting period, SGVV has undertaken various activities to raise awareness, sensitize communities, and engage stakeholders in the fight for children's rights and protection.

The organization is using various methods to prevent child marriage as well, which is not only a social evil but also a legal offense. On the occasion of Akshaya Tritiya, the organization is informing the officials appointed by the state government at the district, block, and panchayat levels about the need to prevent child marriage. Additionally, religious leaders are being made aware of the issue and are being administered an oath that child marriage is a legal offense punishable by law.

Posters are also being put up in religious places, including temples, mosques, churches, and gurudwaras, stating that child marriage is not allowed in these places. Around 150 places in Ranchi district, including Ormanjhi, Bedo, Anagada block, and surrounding areas, have been covered under this campaign."

Some key highlights :

Household Surveys and Social Security Scheme Outreach: Conducting household surveys has enabled us to identify vulnerable families in need of support. We have reached out to 1913 households initially and 268 vulnerable households subsequently, providing them access to various social security schemes.

Community Awareness Programs: SGVV has organized 463 community awareness programs across target areas, reaching over 11,000 individuals, to educate them about the ill effects of child marriage, child labour, child trafficking, and child sexual abuse.

Campaigns and Workshops: From signature campaigns to district-level workshops, SGVV has been actively engaging with the community, government officials, and stakeholders to raise awareness, advocate for policy change, and promote child rights and protection.

With the continuous support from Kailash Satyarthi Children's Foundation (KSCF), US, we have made significant strides in preventing child marriage, rescuing children from exploitative situations, and advocating for their rights. However, the journey towards ensuring justice and protection for every child is ongoing, and we remain committed to our cause.

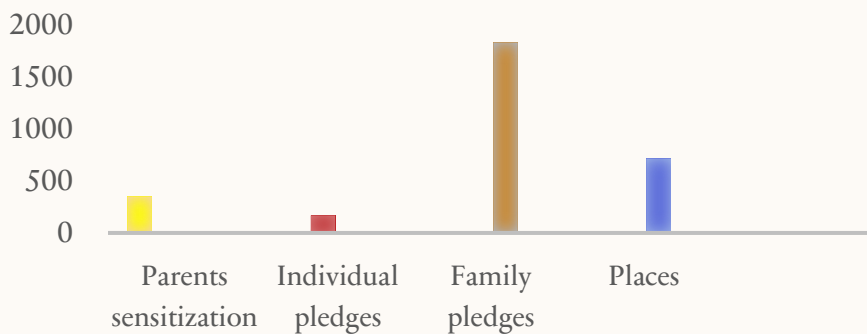

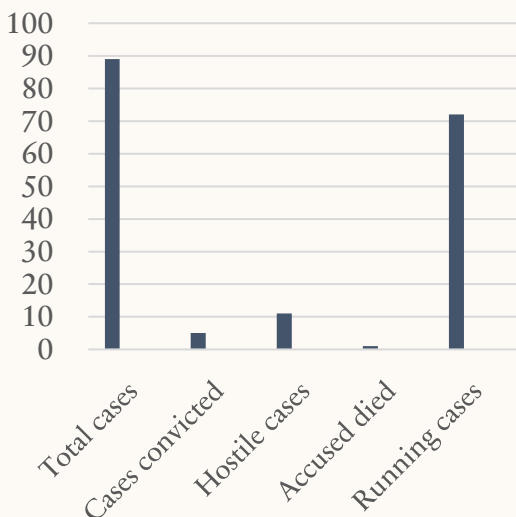

PLEDGES AGAINST CHILD MARRIAGE

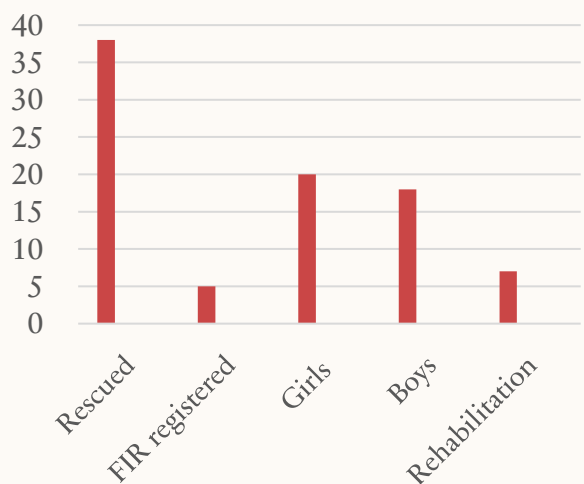

4. Strengthening of Local Governance in Jharkhand

This project aims to empower and uplift the communities within 20 villages of Rania block, Khunti District Jharkhand by strengthening local governance systems, promoting inclusivity, and encouraging active participation in Gram Sabhas. Through targeted training and capacity-building efforts, the project seeks to fortify existing structures, enabling efficient decision-making and improved service delivery. By facilitating access to government programs and schemes, the project is empowering 2216 households to exercise their rights and unlock opportunities for personal and collective growth. The promotion of vibrant, participatory Gram Sabhas has instigated lasting positive changes, fostering self-reliance and ensuring the well-being and prosperity of all community members.



SGVV has organized a capacity-building programs for the community regarding the importance of Gram Sabha and the role of PRI in the development of the village and panchayat. After the training of SGVV, the participation of people has increased, especially among women. Women are presenting their demands in front of the Panchayat. This project also envisions creating a more informed, connected, and empowered community that actively engages with and benefits from various government welfare programs.

5. Two feet Ahead Together

Two feet ahead together is a project funded by Kinderpotzels with the core aim is to empower adolescent children in the age group of 12-18 with critical thinking and problem-solving skills, enabling them to support each other effectively. To achieve this, the project creates a safe and inclusive environment by collaborating with various stakeholders. The project will be carried out in 90 villages across Ramgarh, Gumla, and Ranchi, benefiting 9100 children. In these districts, diverse challenges hinder children's growth and engagement. It seeks to bridge educational gaps and create an enabling environment for these children to thrive. By reaching out to these vulnerable children and implementing community-based interventions, the project aims to ensure that no child is left behind, bringing the initiative to a saturation level of coverage and making a substantial impact on their lives and future prospects

CASE STUDY

Khushbu Khes, a dynamic leader hailing from Charima village in Ita Panchayat, Bero block, has been actively engaged in our initiatives for approximately six months. Her enthusiasm, coupled with a thirst for knowledge and a passion for sharing insights with her peers, sets her apart. Khushbu's unwavering commitment is evident through her active participation in Federation Meetings, trainings, and workshops, demonstrating her dedication to community development.

In Khushbu's village, a prevalent issue looms large - the pervasive consumption of rice beer, leading to detrimental effects on families, particularly the children, who are often drawn into this harmful cycle. Consequently, many children abandon their education, perpetuating a cycle of poverty and illiteracy.

Empowered by her determination to effect change, Khushbu took decisive action. She convened a meeting, uniting parents and children to address the scourge of alcoholism plaguing their community. Undeterred, she led a rally through the village, rallying support from her peers and spreading awareness about the perils of alcoholism.

Amidst her tireless endeavours, Khushbu encountered an eight-year-old boy who had fallen victim to the scourge of alcoholism-induced school dropout. Despite his parents' best efforts, their struggles as daily wage earners hindered their ability to keep him in school. Recognizing the pivotal moment, Khushbu engaged the boy in heartfelt conversations, empathizing with his plight and igniting a spark of hope within him.

Through her unwavering persistence and compassionate guidance, Khushbu succeeded in persuading the young boy to return to the classroom. His decision marked a triumph over adversity, signalling a beacon of hope for his future. Khushbu's transformative leadership not only rescued a child from the clutches of despair but also instilled a sense of purpose within the community.

Khushbu Khes epitomizes the essence of transformative leadership, driven by a deep-rooted commitment to safeguarding the future of her village's children. Her indomitable spirit, coupled with her empathy and resilience, serves as an inspiration to all. By challenging harmful practices and advocating for education, Khushbu is catalysing positive change, one child at a time. Her journey stands as a testament to the transformative power of compassion and community engagement, igniting a beacon of hope for generations to come.

6. Family based Care

The Family-based Care (FBC) initiative in Jharkhand has made significant strides in promoting alternative child care models, as mandated by the Juvenile Justice Act and Integrated Child Protection Scheme. Covering 35 rural villages and 9 urban slum wards, the project focused on kinship care, foster care, sponsorship, and independent living. Our key achievements till date includes educational continuity during COVID-19, preventing child marriages through counselling, linking families to welfare schemes, enhancing team skills, and boosting child participation.

Keeping in account of the phase out process we aim to sustain the success of FBC initiative by providing income generation support to caregivers, combating child marriage through community empowerment, fostering child-centred learning environments, and initiating systematic after care and deinstitutionalization in partnership with the District Child Protection Unit. The project's holistic approach has not only transformed children's lives but also empowered communities, making it a model for collaborative, child-centric interventions. Reflecting on these accomplishments, the initiative remains committed to furthering positive change in Jharkhand's child care and protection landscape.



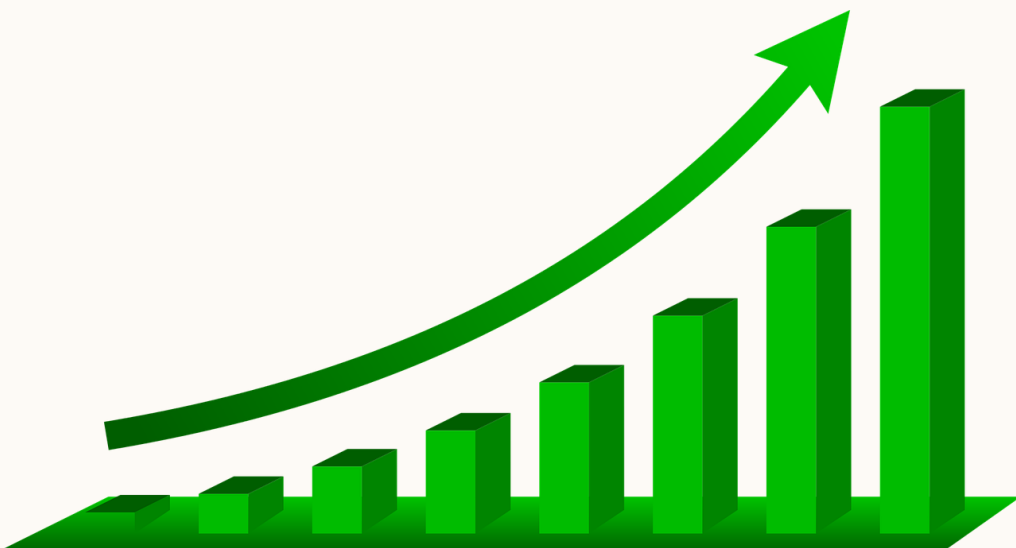

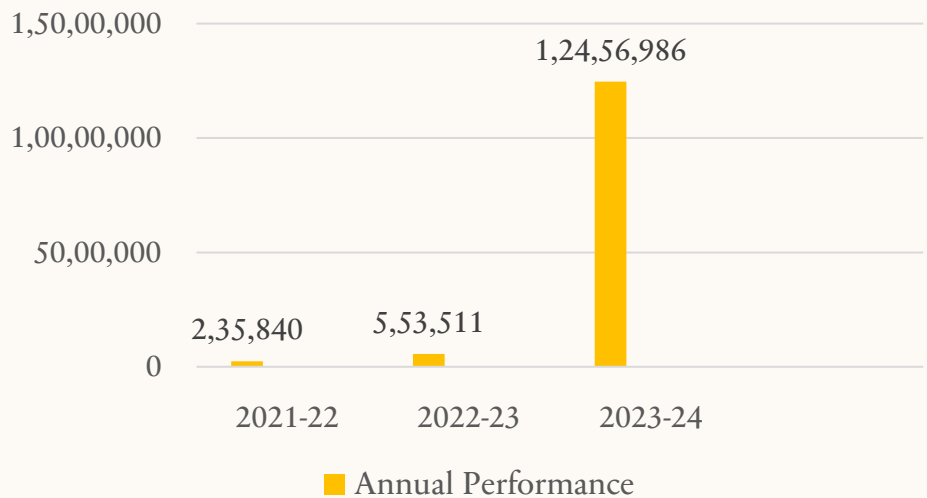

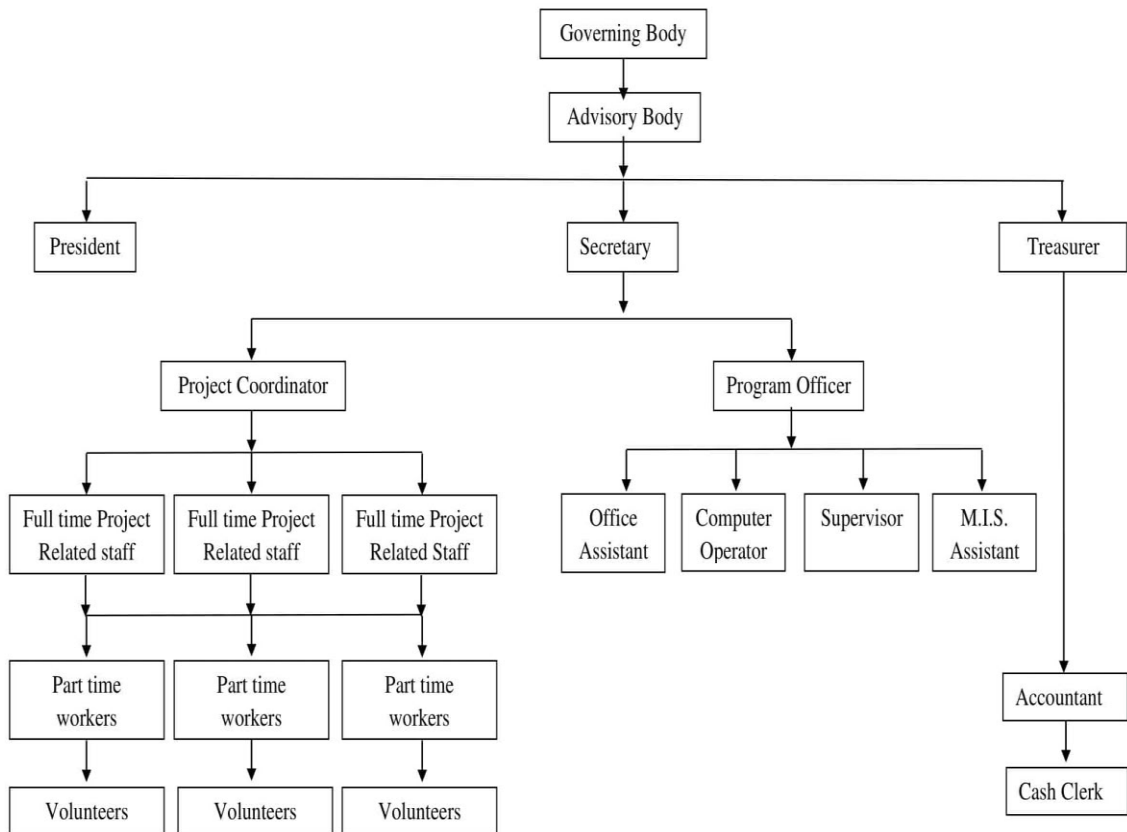
